### **DESE to Conduct Integrated Monitoring Review of Holyoke Community Charter School in February 2026**

The Department of Elementary and Secondary Education's Office of Public School Monitoring (PSM) will conduct an Integrated Monitoring Review of The school in February 2026. Each school district, charter school, vocational school, and virtual school in Massachusetts undergoes an Integrated Monitoring Review every three years. The areas addressed during an Integrated Monitoring Review are organized into two groups, known as Group A Universal Standards and Group B Universal Standards.

The school will be undergoing a **Group A** monitoring review that focuses on special education student identification and special education eligibility timelines; Individualized Education Program (IEP) development; programming and support services; procedural requirements for suspensions and equal opportunity. The process includes interviews with district staff and administrators, a review of student records, policies and procedures, and school building visits. The process may also include parent/caregiver, student and teacher focus group meetings to gather additional information. Interpretation will be provided, if needed.

The Department will also send a parent survey in multiple languages and formats, as needed, to parents/guardians of special education students to gather key information on the special education processes and procedures.
