## IV. <u>Academic Presentation</u>

Every Student Succeeds Act compared to NCLB/using funds differently. Title 1 reduction/but future federal funding? Computer tests expected to begin in 2017 with a paper test accommodation for certain individuals.

"Next Gen" MCAS 2017 levels reviewed/returning to untimed tests.

Grade levels reviewed/State did not release State average. Reduced students in warning level by 2%. This year highest ELA number so far. CPI review for progress throughout years. Can see dips in level when new assessments were presented. Cohorts levels grew but some grade levels did not score as high as the previous same grade level.

## Action plan reviewed

Includes PD/analysis of standards; creation of a graphic organizer; teachers best practices with hands-on examples, workshops for grades 3-8 annotation skills; integrating literacy; conducted integrated PD for math and English; more PD for new teachers; student for multiplication/division skills; checklist creation; create academic visuals; Student Life homework clubs; bring back advising periods
